

NCDC offers four fellowships (out of which 2 reserved for SC/ST candidates) for participation in Diploma in Cooperative Business Management (DCBM) (36 weeks residential course including national/international study visit) at Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Coop. Management (VAMNICOM), Pune. VAMNICOM, Pune has announced the 51st DCBM Course scheduled to be held at Pune during 04th September, 2017 to 13th May, 2018.

NCDC fellowships are awarded to the middle level managers/executives working in the following Cooperative Organizations.

- All state and district level cooperative federations covering sugar factories, spinning mills, poultry, fishery and dairy cooperatives.
- All agricultural cooperative marketing and processing societies including cold storages, sugar mills, spinning mills and all other cooperatives covered by the programmes under the purview of NCDC.

Fellowships are also open to NCDC own officials of the level of Assistants / Programme Officers and Assistant Directors.

The fellowship comprises of a course fee of Rs.40,000/- for residential programme while the participants have to pay a token amount of Rs.750/- per month towards boarding charges.

Candidates should preferably be below 45 years of age, (relaxable in deserving cases for ladies and for SC/ST/OBC) with good knowledge of English and holding at least a bachelor degree with minimum of three years experience in managerial capacity in co-operative organizations / Government Departments.

The application in the prescribed proforma duly recommended by the concerned State Government authority may be sent to Chief Director (TOPIC), National Cooperative Development Corporation, TOPIC Institute, Plot No.89, Sector-18, Gurugram-122015 (Haryana) at the earliest.
