International Cooperatives Trade Fair (IICTF), 2019 - A Grand Success

The first ever India International Cooperatives Trade Fair (IICTF) conceived as a major platform to promote exports of Indian key agriculture commodities and products as per the goals set under the Agriculture Export Policy, 2018, was held at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi from 11th to 13th October, 2019.



- This unique and historic event was organized by NCDC in association with country partner Bangladesh, Bangkok based international organization (NEDAC) and leading organizations in India (NAFED, APEDA, ITPO etc.) with the support of Ministries of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Commerce and Industry and External Affairs. Six State Governments/UTs namely, Telangana, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Puducherry, Meghalaya and Goa were partners of IICTF. IICTF was also supported through partnership with IFFCO, IPL, AMUL, CDB, UPL, FAO, NCUI, LINAC, NAFCUB, NAFSCOB, NCCD etc.

The 3 day event was packed with B2B/C2C Meetings, Exhibitions, Conferences and cultural programmes and was visited by many VVIPs like Governors, Ministers and foreign dignitaries. The IICTF saw a foot fall of more than 35,000 visitors on this 3 day event. In all, 75 business agreements were signed amounting to a, value of USD 1.2 billion approximately. There were 192 exhibitors (145 Indian and 47 Foreign) which included NEDAC. The booth was allocated to 268 exhibitors. 35 countries participated in the event and 141 B2B/C2C meetings were held and attended by 129 foreign visitors.

HIGHLIGHTS - MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS' WELFARE

Three day 'International Seminar on Climate Smart Farming Systems' for BIMSTEC countries was organized by the Department of Agricultural Research & Education, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare and Indian Council of Agricultural Research from 11th to 13th December, 2019 in New Delhi. Participants from all the Seven BIMSTEC Countries viz. Bhutan, Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand and BIMSTEC Secretariat attended the Seminar. The objective of this International Seminar was to have experience sharing to enable improvement of tropical smallholder farming systems for greater productivity and resilience to climate change through ecological approaches.

The Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare has constituted a task force to develop a comprehensive farmers' database for better planning, monitoring, strategy formulation and smooth implementation of schemes for the entire country. This Centralised Farmers Database shall be useful for various activities like issuing soil health cards, dissemination of crop advisories to the farmers, precision farming, smart cards for farmers to facilitate e-governance, crop insurance, settlement of compensation claims, grant of agricultural subsidies, community/village resource centres etc.

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, has approved the extension of timeline upto 31.03.2022and revision of Prime Minister's Development Package (PMDP) for development of Horticulture in the UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH).

As on 30-11-2019, around 7.6 crore farmers in the country have been granted benefit under the 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) Yojana'. An amount of around Rs.36,000 crores has been disbursed under the Scheme.

7)	सचिव की कार्य अवधि	:	1986 से निरन्तर

बात वर्ष 1986 की है, जब श्री राजेश कुमार को जनपद लखनऊ की साधन सहकारी समिति, अनौराकला पर पदस्थ किया गया। उस समय समिति की आर्थिक स्थिति बहुत कमजोर थी, यहां तक कि समिति में सचिव, एकाउण्टेन्ट एवं चौकीदार सहित कुल तीन कर्मचारियों का वेतन भी निकालने में कठिनाई थी। रूपया 2.46 लाख का ऋण एवं उर्वरक व्यवसाय करने वाली समिति में रू0 45000.00 की संकलित हानि एवं रू0 3.50 लाख का ऋण अन्तर था। स्पष्ट है कि श्री राजेश कुमार के समक्ष समिति के अस्तित्व को बनाये रखने की एक बड़ी चुनौती थी, जिसे उन्होंने बड़े साहस के साथ स्वीकार किया और यह निश्चय किया कि उन्हें यदि समिति पर कार्य करने का अवसर दिया गया तो देर से ही सही, किन्तु एक न एक दिन वह समिति का स्वरूप अवश्य बदल देंगे।

''संसाधन नहीं अपितु व्यक्ति महत्वपूर्ण है''

यह बात चरितार्थ होती है जनपद लखनऊ की साधन सहकारी समिति अनौराकला की सफलता की कहानी से। सहकारी संस्थागत जीवन में अक्सर व्यक्ति अपनी असफलता को छिपाने हेतु तरह—तरह की कठिनाइयाँ बताते हैं, जैसे लक्ष्य के सापेक्ष व्यवसाय कम होने पर वह संसाधनों की कमी, व्यवसायिक अवसरों का अभाव, दोषपूर्ण नीतियों का होना, पर्याप्त वेतन न मिलना, कार्य का वातावरण अनुकूल न होना, तकनीकी दृष्टि से पिछड़ा होना, बोर्ड का हस्तक्षेप एवं दोहरा नियंत्रण आदि, परन्तु जनपद लखनऊ की प्राथमिक कृषि ऋण समितियों में एक समिति ऐसी भी है, जहाँ काम करने वाले सचिव श्री राजेश कुमार ने उक्त कठिनाइयों को अपने पुरूषार्थ के बल पर अवसरों में बदल दिया।

करते समय समिति में जो ऋणान्तर की राशि थी, उसे भी धीरे—धीरे उन्होंने समिति द्वारा अर्जित लाभ से वर्ष 2005 तक पूर्णतः समाप्त कर दिया। वर्ष 1989—90 समिति के लिये मील का पत्थर साबित हुआ। क्योंकि इसी वर्ष समिति में सदस्यों की बचत को बढ़ावा देने हेतु मिनी बैंक की स्थापना की गयी तथा प्रारम्भ में वर्ष 1992 में उसमें रू. 2.80 लाख की जमायें भी एकत्र की गयी। सतत सदस्यता वृद्धि, अंशधन वृद्धि, ऋण व्यवसाय, उर्वरक व्यवसाय, निक्षेप तथा उत्कृष्ट ऋण वसूली के बल पर अन्ततः वर्ष 2002 में समिति ने प्रथम बार रू. 15000.00 का शुद्ध लाभ अर्जित किया और उसके पश्चात कभी पीछे मुड़कर नहीं देखा। इसे समिति की गत 35 वर्ष की प्रगति से निम्नानुसार देखा जा सकता है:—

पदभार ग्रहण करते ही श्री राजेश कुमार ने समिति की ऋण वसूली बढ़ाने, सदस्यता वृद्धि करने, निष्क्रिय सदस्यों को सक्रिय करने, ऋणान्तर समाप्त कराने, व्यय पर अंकुश लगाने तथा व्यवसाय वृद्धि करने की दीर्घकालीन रणनीति बनाई तथा उस पर अमल किया। कहा जाता है कि पुरूषार्थ करने वाले की भगवान भी सहायता करते हैं। अतः वर्ष 1989–90 में भारत सरकार द्वारा सहकारी क्षेत्र में रू. 10,000.00 तक के बकाया ऋण माफ किये गये, जिसमें समिति में जो बकाया राशि थी, वह माफ हो गयी। परिणामस्वरूप, समिति की ऋण वसूली वर्ष 1989–90 तक जहां 20 से 25 प्रतिशत तक होती थी, वह बढ़कर 75 से 80 प्रतिशत तक होने लगी।

श्री राजेश कुमार ने जहां व्यवसाय वृद्धि हेतु प्रयास किया, वहीं सदस्यता वृद्धि हेतु भी वे सतत प्रयत्नशील रहे। पदभार ग्रहण

समिति में विशेष उल्लेखनीय घटनाएं

- समिति की अधिकतर कृषि योग्य भूमि शहरी क्षेत्र में जानाः वर्ष 1991 की जनगणना के अनुसार समिति के कार्यक्षेत्र में कुल 4204 हेक्टेयर भूमि पर खेती की जाती थी, किन्तु वर्ष 2002 में समिति के 09 राजस्व ग्रामों में से 05 राजस्व ग्रामों की 2340 हेक्टेयर कृषि योग्य भूमि शहरी क्षेत्र में परिवर्तित हो गयी, फिर भी समिति द्वारा गत 10 वर्षों में ऋण एवं उर्वरक व्यवसाय में लगभग 03 गुने की वृद्धि की गयी। इसमें समिति के सचिव का प्रयास अनुकरणीय है।
- समिति के निक्षेप संचय केन्द्र में निक्षेप संचय : समिति द्वारा गत 10 वर्षों में समिति का निक्षेप रू. 114.86 लाख से बढ़ाकर रू. 473.76 लाख किया गया अर्थात उसमें 312 प्रतिशत की कुल वृद्धि, जो ऐतिहासिक है। विशेष उल्लेखनीय है कि समिति द्वारा एकत्र किये गये कुल निक्षेप रू. 473.76 लाख में मात्र 26.00 लाख रुपये अर्थात 5.4 प्रतिशत सावधि निक्षेप हैं। जबकि शेष रू. 447.76 लाख अर्थात 94.6 प्रतिशत बचत बैंक निक्षेप हैं। इससे समिति की लाभप्रदता काफी हद तक बढी है।
- समिति में लाभ संचय : वर्ष 2006 में समिति का संचित लाभ रू. 2.38 लाख मात्र था, जो कि वर्ष 2019 में बढ़कर 12.58 लाख हो गया अर्थात उसमें 428.57 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि की गयी। सहकारी क्षेत्र में ऐसा उदाहरण प्रायः देखने को नहीं मिलता है।

 समिति में ऋण वसूली : समिति द्वारा गत 10 वर्षों से समिति एवं बैंक के मध्य 100 प्रतिशत एवं समिति एवं सदस्यों के मध्य 95 प्रतिशत ऋण वसूल किया जा रहा है। इस उत्कृष्ट कार्य के लिये वर्ष 2010, 2011 एवं 2012 में सहकारिता विभाग, उ0प्र0 द्वारा उसे पुरस्कृत किया गया है।

सफलता का श्रेय

समिति की उक्त ऐतिहासिक उपलब्धि का श्रेय निश्चित रूप से समिति के सचिव श्री राजेश कुमार को जाता है, क्योंकि अल्पकालीन सहकारी ऋण ढांचा, जो कि वर्तमान में संक्रमण काल से गुजर रहा है, में समिति की इस प्रकार की उपलब्धि एक दैवीय घटना ही कही जायेगी। परन्तु समिति के सचिव जो स्वयं एक बहुत अनुशासित, नेक, ईमानदार एवं कर्मठ अधिकारी हैं, इस उपलब्धि का श्रेय समिति के संचालक मण्डल के अध्यक्ष, उपाध्यक्ष संचालकगणों, बैंक/विभाग के अधिकारियों एवं सदस्यों को देते हैं। वह इस सफलता को समिति के बैंक डेलीगेट, माननीय श्री शिवकूमार सिंह जी, के गत 05 कार्यकालों का अथक सहयोग मानते हैं। जो भी हो अनौराकला की सफलता की कहानी हमारे प्रदेश की उन तमाम प्रारम्भिक कृषि ऋण समितियों, उनके संचालक मण्डलों, सचिव एवं नियंताओं हेतू एक मिसाल है, जो सहकारिता के इस संक्रमण काल में अपनी समितियों को आत्म निर्भर बनाना चाहते हैं।

State of Art Cattle Semen Station -Jagudan, Mehsana

Modern Frozen semen station at Jagudan, Mehsana is run by Dudhsagar Research And Development Association (DURDA), a sister organization of Mehsana District Cooperative Milk Union Ltd, (Dudhsagar Dairy). Mehsana. Centre was established in year 1967 with an objective of developing the cattle breeds, by inducting the High Genetic Merit Bulls for increasing milk productivity of cows and buffaloes. Further with an aim of supplying quality frozen semen doses, having high genetic potential to milk producing farmers in the country, DURDA established "Semen Station" in the year 2005.

Semen station is ISO 9001:2015 certified and has been awarded "A Grade" semen station, certificate by Department of Animal husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare Government of India. Centre has collaboration with ABS India, subsidiary of ABS global a US based company. Company uses SexcelTM technology for sexed genetics products i.e. selective breeding in cattle / buffaloes. It uses one of the most advanced technologies available globally, combined with superior fertility treads and ABS genetics for achieving higher chances of female calf pregnancies. Technology is used for

breeding offspring of a desired sex (female calf in case of dairy industry). This technology ensures upto 90% chance of birth of female calves in cows and buffaloes, in comparison with natural 50%-50% chances of female -male calf. This Facility produces and sells high quality semen doses of Mehsana & Murrah buffalo and CBHF, HF, Gir, Kankrej, Sahiwal breeds of cattle.
