Highlights - Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare

- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, has given its approval for the Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) for copra for 2020 season. The MSP for Fair Average Quality (FAQ) of milling copra has been increased to Rs. 9,960/- per quintal for 2020 season from Rs. 9,521/- per quintal in 2019 and the MSP for ball copra has been increased to Rs. 10,300/- per quintal for 2020 season from Rs. 9,920/- per quintal in 2019. This will accrue a benefit of Rs 439/- per quintal in the milling copra and Rs 380/- increase in the BallCopra.
- The Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar inaugurated the Pusa Krishi Vigyan Mela-2020 on 1st March, 2020.



• The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) gave its approval for a scheme for the formation of 10,000 Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) in five years to ensure economies of scale for farmers. Government of India launched new Central sector scheme titled "Formation and Promotion of Farmer Produce Organizations (FPOs)" aimed at forming and promoting 10,000 new FPOs with a total budgetary provision of Rs 4,496 crore for five years.

EMPLOYEES CORNER

Case Study of Purusottampur SCS, Balasore, Odisha

Sh. Radhashyam Pradhan, a progressive farmer, established Purusottampur Gram PanchyatGraangolla Co-operative Society in the year 1961 to provide loan to 174 members with a view to free them from exploitation of money-lenders. The said society was converted to Primary Agriculture Co-operative Society as per the recommendation of all India Rural Credit Survey Committee in the year 1967.

Commencing its operation with a share capital of Rs.2538.00 and working capital of Rs.20,209.50 the Society has grown substantially and as on March,2019, share capital of the society stood at Rs.89.10 lakh and working capital stood at Rs.11252.81 lakh. Society is providing computerized customer service from 12.06.2005. Society incurred profit of Rs.419.49 in the year of 1967 and continued to earn profit till 2019. During the year 2018-19, society earned a net profit of Rs.38.94 lakh and society also distributes dividend to its members. Involvement and participation of the members towards their society were so high such that they have contributed their dividend towards construction of multi-storied building. The dreams of members came true when the construction of two-storied building completed in the year 1996-97. Out of 3612 members, 1926 members attended Annual General Body meeting in the year 2018-19.

During 1971, entire betel vine orchards were destroyed due to cyclone and it weakened and affected the financial back bone of the villagers, as it was their only source of income. No financial institutions came forward to help them for reconstructing their orchards. When the affected villagers were in the midst of disappointment, under the guidance of BalasoreBhadrak Central Co-operative Bank Ltd, Purusottampur SCS had financed members for reconstruction of the destroyed orchards although there was no approved scheme. This attitude of the society changed the minds of the villagers and they began to actively participate in the functioning of the society. From betel vine cultivation, members of the society earned huge income by selling the betel in Mumbai, Banaras and Delhi. At present the economic status of the villagers has already been changed.
