PURPOSE & SCOPE

- iv. Make efforts to sponsor or to invite each other or to jointly operationalize for national and international training activities, research activities, studies, research, seminars, conferences and workshops.

This non-legally binding and no-liability to the respective parties, document shall come into effect, upon the signatures, at Gurugram, India, and shall remain in force for a period of three years, and, get extended, automatically, for further periods of three years, unless terminated by either party with a notice in writing at least three (3) months prior to termination.
